## “It’s Good to Be Green” EcoProject Contest

### Primary School Division (Grades 1-3)

**EcoAvenues** is a **FREE** event created by the Cities of Avondale, Goodyear, Litchfield Park, Tolleson, Town of Buckeye, Southwest Valley and Buckeye Valley Chambers of Commerce and Estrella Mountain Community College that gives attendees information and resources to help them live a more sustainable life, run a more sustainable business and heighten their awareness of what it means to be ‘Green’. Along with exhibitors, demonstrations, kids activities and live music all centralized around a sustainability theme we will be displaying entries and publicly awarding EcoProject Contest winners for Grades 1, 2 and 3.

Elementary school students may select one drawing to color and submit for the EcoProject Contest. All entries will be displayed at EcoAvenues on March 26, 2011.

#### Rules:

- We would appreciate any participation from teachers to encourage the submittal of entries in this contest.
- We ask that teachers direct their students to the EcoAvenues website at [www.ecoavenues.com](http://www.ecoavenues.com) to download one picture to color and submit for the EcoProject Contest.
- We ask that teachers collect all entries and have them available in one location so that a member of the EcoAvenues Steering Committee can pick up all entries from your school’s administration office after 12PM on March 14<sup>th</sup>.
- In order for the student to have their drawing judged they must completely fill out the contact details on the entry form.
- All artwork can be picked up by the student, family or teacher at 2PM at EcoAvenues on March 26<sup>th</sup>. If artwork entries are not picked up at EcoAvenues by 4PM on March 26<sup>th</sup> the entries will not be saved.
- Participants agree to abide by all decisions of the EcoAvenues Steering Committee, which shall be final and binding with respect to all issues relating to this contest.
- The EcoAvenues Steering Committee is not responsible for problems including (but not limited to) damaged, lost, delayed, or defective entries.
- The EcoAvenues Steering Committee reserves the right to modify, cancel, postpone or end the contest at any time as necessary, at its sole discretion, or to disqualify any participant or winner, at its sole discretion, deemed to have cheated, destroyed, obstructed, or otherwise acted illegally or in bad faith in relation to this contest.

**Judging:** The EcoAvenues Steering Committee will randomly draw one entry from each grade level to win a prize. The teacher listed on the drawing will be contacted about their student’s award and any prize will be sent to that instructor to distribute to the student if the student is not present at EcoAvenues on March 26<sup>th</sup>.

All students' artwork will be displayed at EcoAvenues and it is suggested that students and their families attend the event.
